Boyd, Lizi. *Flashlight*. In this wordless story, a child explores the woods after dark with a flashlight.

Brown, Peter. *Mr. Tiger Goes Wild*. Bored with city life and proper behavior, Mr. Tiger has a wild idea that leads him to discover his true nature and inspire his friends.

De La Peña, Matt. *Last Stop on Market Street*. A young boy rides the bus across town with his grandmother and learns to appreciate the beauty in everyday things.

DiPucchio, Kelly. *Gaston*. A very proper bulldog raised in a poodle family and a tough poodle raised in a bulldog family meet one day in the park.

Fogliano, Julie. *If You Want to See a Whale*. Learn what to do, and not to do, to successfully spot a whale, such as wrapping up in a not-too-cozy blanket, ignoring the roses, and always being patient.

Freedman, Deborah. *By Mouse and Frog*. Mouse has one idea about what a book should be and how to tell a story. Frog has another. What happens when they try to create a book together?
