Computer Animation Workshop Application

The North Shelby Library is offering a one week computer animation workshop to upcoming 6th-12th graders. The purpose of the class is to introduce students to the technology and software that the animation industry utilizes on a daily basis. The course is taught by a professional artist.

The workshop will meet from 10 am-12:30 pm each morning, June 10-14. Students chosen to participate are expected to attend all classes and make a 1-3 minute film as a final project. Space in the workshop is limited.

To apply, answer the following questions on a separate piece of paper or in a word document and submit them to the Teen Department at North Shelby Library by 6 pm on Monday, June 3. You can submit applications in person or via email to: nsyouth@shelbycounty-al.org. If you submit your application through email, you will receive a confirmation of receipt. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

1. Name, phone number, email address, school, & grade in fall
2. How did you become interested in computer animation?
3. Do you have any experience with creative software; graphical, animation, or otherwise?
(none is necessary)
4. Do you work better in a group or by yourself?
5. List a few of your animation influences; computer generated and traditional
6. Why should you be chosen for this workshop?
7. Can you attend all 5 classes?

While all are encouraged to apply, please note that priority will be given to those applicants who have not yet taken a computer animation workshop at North Shelby Library.

Successful applicants will be notified on or before June 5. All participants MUST be registered for the Teen Summer Reading program.
